Plymouth, MN – June 2, 2010 – Mar Cor Purification, a wholly owned subsidiary of **CANTEL MEDICAL CORP.** (NYSE: CMN), announced today that it had acquired Purity Water of San Antonio, Inc. This continues the expansion of Mar Cor's service center network for the water purification and filtration segment. Purity Water provides water treatment equipment and services for laboratory, industrial, medical, pharmaceutical and semiconductor customers in Texas and neighboring states. The acquired business had pre-acquisition revenues of approximately \$3.0 million. This cash deal is expected to be slightly accretive to Cantel's earnings per share in the first year.

I am very pleased with the leadership of our Mar Cor group, and we will continue to invest both organically and via acquisition in this business, which is now Cantel's largest reporting segment in annual revenue. The team has done an outstanding job bringing this deal to fruition."
